Gordon J. Christensen, DDS, MSD, PhD - Dr. Gordon J. Christensen is Founder and Director of Practical Clinical Courses (PCC), CEO of Clinicians Report Foundation (CR), and a Practicing Prosthodontist in Provo, Utah. Christensen is co-founder of the non-profit Clinicians Report Foundation (previously named CRA). Since 1976, they have conducted research in all areas of dentistry and published in the well-known CRA Newsletter, now called Clinicians Report. Dr. Christensen is an adjunct professor at the University of Utah, School of Dentistry. He has presented thousands of hours of continuing education globally, made hundreds of educational videos used throughout the world, and published widely.
